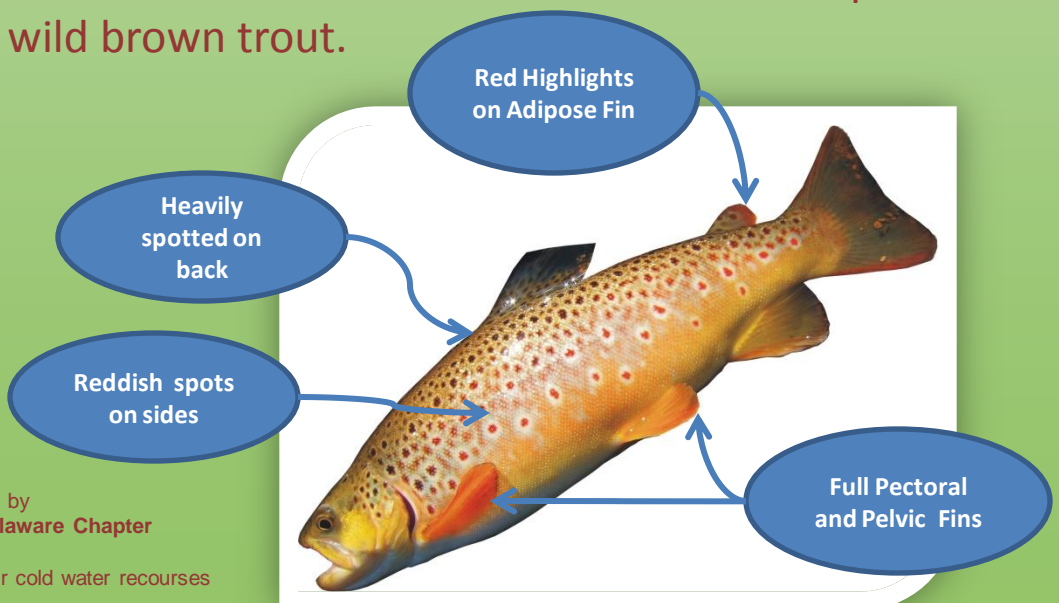




Wild Brown Trout

Wild trout are born naturally in their home watersheds, spend their juvenile years adapting to the stream in a never ending struggle for survival, and their adult lives in the pursuit of acceptable spawning partners and habitat. It is this constant battle for survival which makes the wild trout such a wonderful asset to our watershed as they are hardier, warier, and more able to survive in the wild than their stocked counterparts. To protect the wild brown trout population in this stream we urge you to please consider practicing catch and release of these special fish. If you wish to keep trout for the dinner table rainbow and brook trout which are stocked as adults are a better choice. Please take a moment to review these tips for identifying wild brown trout.
